## A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the week of January 23 through 29, 2005, as  
2 "Pennsylvania Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetists Week."

3 WHEREAS, The demand for anesthesia services expands beyond  
4 hospitals into physicians' offices and other nontraditional  
5 settings; and

6 WHEREAS, Certified registered nurse anesthetists (CRNAs) have  
7 been providing high-quality care in this Commonwealth for more  
8 than 100 years, keeping patient safety as their first priority;  
9 and

10 WHEREAS, CRNAs are trained to administer anesthetics, provide  
11 patient care and stay with patients throughout surgery; and

12 WHEREAS, CRNAs practice in every setting in which anesthesia  
13 is delivered, including traditional hospital surgical suites,

1 obstetrical delivery rooms, physicians' offices, ambulatory  
2 surgical centers and medical facilities of the United States  
3 military, Public Health Service and Veterans Administration; and

4 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth is proud to have more than 2,300  
5 practicing CRNAs consistently administering safe, high-quality  
6 anesthesia care; therefore be it

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the  
8 week of January 23 through 29, 2005, as "Pennsylvania Certified  
9 Registered Nurse Anesthetists Week."
