AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for prohibition on expenditure
- 3 for emission inspection program.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 4706 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 8 § 4706. Prohibition on expenditures for emission inspection
- 9 program.
- 10 * * *
- 11 (d.1) Newly purchased vehicles.--Notwithstanding any other
- 12 provision of this title to the contrary, no new motor vehicle
- 13 that has been purchased shall be subject to an emission
- 14 inspection under this subchapter within one year of the date of
- 15 purchase, and the first emission inspection on such vehicle may
- 16 be conducted in conjunction with the first safety inspection of
- 17 the vehicle. A copy of the sales agreement for such vehicle

- shall be sufficient evidence of compliance with this section for 1
- 2 <u>12 months from the date of purchase, provided that the sales</u>
- 3 agreement is maintained in the vehicle. Any dealer who sells a
- 4 <u>vehicle subject to emission inspection under this section shall</u>
- 5 inform the purchaser at the time of sale about the provisions of
- 6 this subsection.

- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
