A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the week of September 9 through 15, 2018, as
 "Nephrology Nurses Week" and asking all residents of this
 Commonwealth to join in honoring the nephrology nurses who
 care for patients with kidney disease.
- 5 WHEREAS, Nearly 30 million Americans suffer from kidney
- 6 disease and every year many Pennsylvania residents, including
- 7 children, adults and elderly individuals, are diagnosed with
- 8 kidney disease; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The depth and breadth of the nephrology nursing
- 10 profession meet the different and emerging kidney disease needs
- 11 as well as other health care needs of the population of this
- 12 Commonwealth; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The American Nephrology Nurses Association is
- 14 working to advance quality care for Americans with kidney
- 15 disease before they suffer complete organ failure, increase
- 16 awareness in local communities, positively influence patient

- 1 outcomes and keep nephrology nurses abreast of the latest
- 2 treatments and kidney-related research; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Nephrology nurses function as educators, direct
- 4 caregivers and coordinators to help patients manage their lives
- 5 while effectively dealing with health issues; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The number of new patients diagnosed with kidney
- 7 disease doubled through the 1980s and 1990s; and
- 8 WHEREAS, More qualified nephrology nurses are needed to meet
- 9 the increasingly complex needs of patients who are experiencing
- 10 or are at risk for kidney disease; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Along with the American Nephrology Nurses
- 12 Association, the ANNA Keystone Chapter has declared the week of
- 13 September 9 through 15, 2018, as "Nephrology Nurses Week" to
- 14 celebrate and honor the unselfish work nephrology nurses perform
- 15 each day to maintain the health of thousands of individuals with
- 16 kidney disease; therefore be it
- 17 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 18 week of September 9 through 15, 2018, as "Nephrology Nurses
- 19 Week" and ask all residents of this Commonwealth to join in
- 20 honoring the nephrology nurses who care for patients with kidney
- 21 disease; and be it further
- 22 RESOLVED, That the residents of this Commonwealth celebrate
- 23 nephrology nurses' efforts to advance patient care and reduce
- 24 the incidence of kidney disease and show appreciation for
- 25 nephrology nurses not just during this week but at every
- 26 opportunity throughout the year.
