AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- 2 act relating to the public school system, including certain
- 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- 4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- 5 laws relating thereto, providing school lunch reimbursement
- 6 payments from the Commonwealth.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 Section 1337.1. School Lunch Reimbursement.--(a) Subject to
- 13 <u>future adjustments under subsection (b), each school building</u>
- 14 which offers the lunch program shall receive an additional
- 15 reimbursement of two cents (2¢) for a total reimbursement of

- 1 eight cents (8¢) per lunch served for the 1998-1999 school year.
- 2 (b) For the 1999-2000 school year, and each school year
- 3 thereafter, financial incentives shall be fixed by regulation of
- 4 the Department of Education. No financial incentives shall be
- 5 less than the amounts established in subsection (a) for the
- 6 <u>1998-1999 school year.</u>
- 7 (c) Financial incentives shall be paid to school districts
- 8 during the school year in which they are earned based on reports
- 9 <u>submitted to the Department of Education</u>.
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
