AN ACT

Amending the act of March 11, 1971 (P.L.104, No.3), entitled, as 2 amended, "An act providing property tax or rent rebate and 3 inflation dividends to certain senior citizens, widows, 4 widowers and permanently disabled persons with limited 5 incomes; establishing uniform standards and qualifications for eligibility to receive rebates and dividends; providing 7 for transportation assistance grants and grants to area agencies on aging for services to older persons; and imposing 8 9 duties upon the Department of Revenue, "further defining the 10 term "household income." 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 12 hereby enacts as follows: 13 Section 1. Section 3(2) of the act of March 11, 1971 14 (P.L.104, No.3), known as the Senior Citizens Rebate and Assistance Act, reenacted and amended December 21, 1979 16 (P.L.570, No.131), is amended to read: 17 Section 3. Definitions. -- As used in this act: 18 "Household income" means all income received by the 19
