7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. Section 4 of the act of May 31, 1945 (P.L.1198,
10	No.418), known as the Surface Mining Conservation and
11	Reclamation Act, is amended by adding a subsection to read:
12	Section 4. Mining Permit; Reclamation Plan; Bond* * *
13	(d.1) Notwithstanding any provision of this act, a
14	municipality which owns or operates a gravel pit, OPERATES OR
15	LEASES AS LESSOR OR LESSEE A GRAVEL PIT FOR DIRECT USE BY THE
16	MUNICIPALITY shall not be required to post a bond with the
17	department.
