AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), entitled  
2 "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending,  
3 revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating  
4 thereto," further providing for separate bid specifications  
5 for different branches of work.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. Section 1805 of the act of June 24, 1931  
9 (P.L.1206, No.331), known as The First Class Township Code,  
10 reenacted and amended May 27, 1949 (P.L.1955, No.569) and  
11 amended July 10, 1990 (P.L.389, No.92), is amended to read:

12 Section 1805. Separate Specifications for Branches of  
13 Work.--In the preparation of specifications for the erection or  
14 alteration of any public building, [when the entire cost of such  
15 work exceeds ten thousand dollars,] the architect, engineer, or  
16 person preparing such specifications [shall] may prepare  
17 separate specifications for the plumbing, heating, ventilating,  
18 and electrical work, and the township [shall] may receive

- 1 separate bids upon each of such branches of work, and award the
- 2 contract for the same to the lowest responsible bidder.
- 3     Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
