1 2 3	Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for criminal history record information.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 9106 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
8	§ 9106. Prohibited information.
9	Intelligence information, investigative information and
10	treatment information shall not be collected [in the central
11	repository nor] in any automated or electronic criminal justice
12	information system. This prohibition shall not preclude the
13	collection [in the central repository or] in any automated or
14	electronic criminal justice information system of names, words,
15	numbers, phrases or other similar index keys to serve as indices
16	to investigative reports. This section does not apply to the
17	Pennsylvania Crime Commission; the Pennsylvania State Police;
18	the Office of Attorney General; the Department of Corrections;

the Pennsylvania Board of Probation and Parole; the Board of 1 2 Pardons; the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinguency; 3 the Pennsylvania Commission on Sentencing; countywide prisons 4 and jails; countywide probation and parole offices; countywide law enforcement agencies, including district attorneys' offices; 5 and police departments of municipalities. 6 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
