## HOUSE BILL No. 1440 Session of 1995

## AN ACT

- 1 Appropriating money from the Sunny Day Fund to the Department of
- 2 Commerce for various projects throughout this Commonwealth
- 3 for fiscal year 1995-1996.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The sums set forth in this act, or as much
- 7 thereof as may be necessary, are hereby specifically
- 8 appropriated from the Sunny Day Fund to the Department of
- 9 Commerce for fiscal year July 1, 1995, to June 30, 1996, for the
- 10 projects listed to enhance economic development and the creation
- 11 of jobs in this Commonwealth in accordance with the provisions
- 12 of Ch. 1 of the act of July 1, 1985 (P.L.120, No.32), known as
- 13 the Sunny Day Fund Act.
- 14 Section 2. The following amounts are appropriated to the
- 15 Department of Commerce to induce companies to locate large
- 16 industrial, manufacturing or research and development
- 17 enterprises within this Commonwealth:
- 18 (1) For the purpose of making a loan,

1 either directly or through an industrial 2 development agency as defined in section 3 of 3 the act of May 17, 1956 (1955 P.L.1609, 4 No.537), known as the Pennsylvania Industrial 5 Development Authority Act, to Bush Industries, 6 Inc., to construct a new distribution and 7 manufacturing facility in Erie County. It is 8 estimated that this project will create 300 new 9 jobs within three years of operation. 10 11 (2) For the purpose of making a loan, 12 either directly or through an industrial 13 development agency as defined in section 3 of the Pennsylvania Industrial Development 14 15 Authority Act, to Berg Electronics, Inc., to 16 construct a manufacturing facility in 17 Huntingdon County. It is estimated that this 18 project will create 500 new jobs within three 19 years of operation. 20 21 Section 3. It is the intent of the General Assembly that the 22 appropriations in section 2 shall be loaned at an annual 23 interest rate that in no case shall be less than the Pennsylvania Industrial Development Authority's rate for the 24 25 area in which the project is located and for a term that shall 26 be the same as the term for an equivalent Pennsylvania Industrial Development Authority project. Private companies 27 28 which receive Sunny Day Fund assistance but fail to make the 29 investment in the enterprise development as specified in section 30 2 shall be liable for the repayment of all Sunny Day Fund

- 1 moneys, including any accrued interest thereon and any penalties
- 2 set by the Secretary of Commerce. Private companies which
- 3 receive Sunny Day Fund assistance but fail to create the number
- 4 of jobs specified in the approved loan or other agreements with
- 5 the Commonwealth shall be liable for a penalty equal to an
- 6 increase in the interest charged to 2% greater than the current
- 7 prime interest rate for the remainder of the loan, unless the
- 8 penalty is waived by the Secretary of Commerce because the
- 9 failure is due to circumstances outside of the control of the
- 10 private company. The Secretary of Commerce shall consult with
- 11 the chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate and
- 12 the chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the House of
- 13 Representatives prior to the establishment of waiver of
- 14 penalties.
- 15 Section 4. For a period equal to the term of assistance
- 16 provided each project approved under this act, the Department of
- 17 Commerce shall provide a written report on the status of each
- 18 project to the Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of
- 19 the House of Representatives by June 30 of each year. This
- 20 report shall contain, at a minimum, information pertaining to
- 21 the specific use of the Sunny Day Fund money, the interest rate
- 22 and term of the Sunny Day Fund loan, the amount of principal
- 23 outstanding and interest due on the loan and the number of jobs
- 24 created by the project. All recipients of funds under this act
- 25 shall be required to provide any and all information required by
- 26 the Department of Commerce for the purpose of this act.
- 27 Section 5. No funds under this act shall be awarded by the
- 28 Department of Commerce after June 30, 1997. Any funds from this
- 29 appropriation remaining unexpended or unencumbered on June 30,
- 30 1997, shall automatically lapse into the Sunny Day Fund.

- Section 6. This act shall take effect July 1, 1995, or 1
- 2 immediately, whichever is later.
