## AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled 2 "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 3 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative 5 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 8 9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 10 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 12 13 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 14 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 16 17 and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the 18 number and compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 19 20 commissions shall be determined, "further providing for 21 membership on the State Transportation Commission. 22 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 23 hereby enacts as follows: 24 Section 1. Subsections (a) and (b) of section 468, act of 25 April 29, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as "The Administrative 26 Code of 1929, " amended May 6, 1970 (P.L.356, No.120), are amended to read: 27
- 28 Section 468. State Transportation Commission.--(a) There is

- 1 hereby created a State Transportation Commission which shall
- 2 consist of [thirteen] fifteen members, one of whom shall be the
- 3 Secretary of Transportation, ex officio, who shall be the
- 4 chairman of the commission. The chairman of the Committee on
- 5 Highways of the Senate and the chairman of the Committee on
- 6 Transportation of the House of Representatives, respectively,
- 7 shall be ex officio members of the commission.
- 8 (b) The Governor shall nominate and by and with the advice
- 9 and consent of two-thirds of all the members of the Senate,
- 10 appoint [eight] ten of the remaining members of the commission,
- 11 not more than [four] five of whom shall be members of the same
- 12 political party, for terms of six years: Provided, That one of
- 13 the two members who is to be appointed by virtue of his
- 14 membership on the board of directors of a transportation
- 15 authority shall be appointed for an initial term of four years.
- 16 Not more nor less than one appointed member of the commission
- 17 shall be a resident of the counties of Philadelphia and
- 18 Allegheny, respectively. At least two of the members of the
- 19 commission shall be members of the aviation community, one of
- 20 whom shall represent commuter or regularly scheduled airlines
- 21 and one of whom shall be a representative of general aviation.
- 22 Effective with the first two appointments after the adoption of
- 23 this act at least two of the appointees of the Governor shall be
- 24 members of the board of directors of a transportation authority
- 25 at the time of their appointment: Provided, That said authority
- 26 appointees shall not be considered residents of either
- 27 Philadelphia or Allegheny County for the purpose of the
- 28 preceding sentence. The present members of the commission shall
- 29 be entitled to complete their present terms and may be
- 30 reappointed at the completion thereof.

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- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
