AN ACT

Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, extending a police officer's power of arrest and custody beyond the limits of the officer's political subdivision.
The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
§ 8902. Duration of intrastate arrest and custody powers.
Irrespective of the territorial limits of a political
subdivision, the police officer's power of arrest and custody
shall be effective from the time of an arrest to the time of
incarceration or the setting of bail. Officers holding an
individual in custody in a political subdivision other than the
one in which the arrest occurred shall have the power of arrest
over that individual to the same extent as it is available to
police officers of the subdivision in which the arrest occurred.
Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
