AN ACT

Repealing the act of June 19, 1941 (P.L.142, No.77), entitled "An act authorizing political subdivisions to appropriate money for participation in Federal Surplus Commodities Stamp plans; to borrow money and issue bonds for said purpose; providing for payment of such appropriations into a special fund in the State Treasury; appropriating the money in such fund, and authorizing the purchase of necessary insurance."

- 9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. The act of June 19, 1941 (P.L.142, No.77),
