21	for certain State-related universities; providing for the
22	disposition of unused borrowing capacity which may become
23	available through the operation of the Higher Education
24	Facilities Act of 1963 or other Federal grants; harmonizing
25	the language of certain existing amendments; allocating
26	unused funds; providing for the interpretation of certain
27	amendments to the act; further defining the powers and
28	procedures of the board; regulating the leasing of projects
29	constructed for State-aided institutions; amending the
30	eminent domain powers and procedures of the Authority;
31	specifically itemizing projects for capital budget purposes,"

to reduce the amount of unallocated funds available for allocation by the board to certain projects for cost-overrun, and to provide for additional projects necessitated by the Great Flood of July 1977.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Clause XXVIII of section 7, act of July 20, 1968 (P.L.652, No.220), entitled "An act amending the act of March 8 31, 1949 (P.L.372, No.34), entitled 'An act to promote the 9 10 welfare of the people of the Commonwealth; creating The General 11 State Authority as a body corporate and politic with power to 12 construct, improve, equip, furnish, and operate projects, and to lease the same, and to fix fees, rentals, and charges for the 13 14 use thereof; authorizing and regulating the issuance of bonds 15 for said Authority, and providing for the payment of such bonds, and the rights of the holders thereof; and to enter into 16 17 agreements with the Government of the United States or any Federal agency; and authorizing the Department of Property and 18 19 Supplies to grant, assign, convey, or lease to the Authority lands of the Commonwealth and interests therein, and to acquire 20 lands therefor; granting the right of eminent domain; empowering 21 22 The General State Authority to sell and convey projects and property to the Commonwealth; and providing that no debt of the 23 24 Commonwealth shall be incurred in the exercise of any of the 25 powers granted by this act, ' empowering the Authority to 26 construct and acquire projects for certain State-related universities; providing for the disposition of unused borrowing 27 28 capacity which may become available through the operation of the 29 Higher Education Facilities Act of 1963 or other Federal grants; harmonizing the language of certain existing amendments; 30 allocating unused funds; providing for the interpretation of 31

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1 certain amendments to the act; further defining the powers and 2 procedures of the board; regulating the leasing of projects 3 constructed for State-aided institutions; amending the eminent 4 domain powers and procedures of the Authority; specifically 5 itemizing projects for capital budget purposes," is amended and 6 the section is amended by adding a clause to read:

7 Section 7. For capital budget purposes the following public 8 improvement projects to be financed by the issuing of debt and 9 to be constructed by The General State Authority, its successors 10 or assigns, and which are in addition to those projects itemized 11 in the "Capital Budget Act for the 1968-1969 Fiscal Year" are 12 hereby specifically itemized, together with their respective 13 estimated financial costs, as follows:

15 XXVIII. Additional funds to be allocated by the board 16 of the authority to such of the public improve-17 ment projects specifically itemized in a capital 18 budget for constructions by the General State 19 Authority as are not bid within the estimated 20 financial costs specified in such capital budget but this amount shall not otherwise constitute 21 22 unallocated funds of the General State Author-23 ity for any other purpose.....
