AN ACT

1 2	Requiring the Department of Transportation to provide for certain maintenance on State highways.
3	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4	hereby enacts as follows:
5	Section 1. Except as provided in section 2, the Department
6	of Transportation shall be responsible for removing from all
7	highways, which are part of the State highway system, at least
8	once each year, all sand, gravel or cinders which were deposited
9	by said department as part of its procedures to maintain safe
10	conditions on such highways.
11	Section 2. The department is authorized to contract with any
12	municipality for the purpose of having such municipality remove
13	said sand, gravel or cinders from any highways which form part
14	of the State highway system and which is situate within the
15	boundaries of said municipality.

16 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
