## AN ACT

Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), entitled, as amended, "An act relating to counties of the first, third, 3 fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto; relating to imposition of excise taxes by counties, including authorizing imposition of an excise tax on the 7 rental of motor vehicles by counties of the first class; and 8 providing for regional renaissance initiatives," further providing for compensation of solicitors appointed by county 9 10 officers. 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 12 hereby enacts as follows: 13 Section 1. Section 1630 of the act of August 9, 1955 14 (P.L.323, No.130), known as The County Code, amended December 6, 1972 (P.L.1421, No.309), is amended to read: 15 16 Section 1630. Compensation of Solicitors Appointed by County 17 Officers. -- The county commissioners may appropriate money for 18 the payment of any solicitor appointed pursuant to this act by a county treasurer, sheriff, prothonotary, register of wills, 19 recorder of deeds, clerk of courts of quarter sessions and oyer 20 and terminer, coroner [or], a clerk of orphans' court or the 21

- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
