AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, prohibiting secret workplace
- 3 surveillance.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 7331. Secret workplace surveillance.
- 9 (a) Offense defined. -- A person commits an offense if he,
- 10 being an employer or an officer, manager or employee of any
- 11 employer, hires any person or is hired for the purpose of secret
- 12 watch, surveillance or reporting to the employer of the work
- 13 behavior or personal habits of employees.
- 14 (b) Exceptions. -- Subsection (a) shall not apply to:
- 15 (1) General management and supervisory practices
- 16 required to evaluate employees' work performance executed by
- 17 <u>management personnel.</u>

- 1 (2) Employees who openly disclose prior to their service
- that they will be observing and reporting employee behavior.
- 3 (3) Academic studies compiling data, provided individual
- 4 <u>names of employees are not disclosed.</u>
- 5 (4) Reports compiled by employers relating to illegal
- 6 <u>activities of employees if the employer has probable cause to</u>
- 7 <u>believe illegal activity is occurring at the workplace.</u>
- 8 (c) Penalty. -- Whoever hires another or is hired in violation
- 9 of subsection (a) shall be fined in an amount not to exceed
- 10 \$1,000 for each violation.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
