AN ACT

1 Prohibiting the sale of leaded gasoline in Pennsylvania.

2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
3 hereby enacts as follows:

4 Section 1. Prohibition.

5 No person shall sell or offer for sale leaded gasoline or any
6 gasoline substitute which contains lead or tetraethyllead.

7 Section 2. Exclusions.

8 This act shall not apply to any vehicle which is registered
9 as a farm vehicle or used solely on a farm, nor shall it apply
10 to any vehicle registered as an antique or classic vehicle. This
11 act shall not apply to any vehicle used exclusively in the
12 construction business in use on the effective date of this act,
13 nor shall it apply to any vehicle in which the engine would be
14 damaged by use of unleaded gasoline.

15 Section 3. Penalty.

16 A person who violates section 1 commits a summary offense
17 and, upon conviction shall, be sentenced to pay a fine of not

1 less than \$250 nor more than \$1,000 or be sentenced to undergo
2 imprisonment for a period not to exceed 90 days. Each sale of
3 leaded gasoline shall constitute a separate offense.

4 Section 4. Enforcement.

5 The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation shall have the
6 power and duty to enforce the provisions of this act.

7 Section 5. Effective date.

8 This act shall take effect in six months.
