- Amending Title 71 (State Government) of the Pennsylvania 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for creditable 3 nonstate service. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 5304(c) of Title 71 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: § 5304. Creditable nonstate service. 8 9 10 (c) Limitations on nonstate service. -- Creditable nonstate 11 service credit shall be limited to: (1)intervening military service;

- 13 (2) other military service not exceeding five years;
- service in any public school or public educational 14
- 15 institution in any state other than this Commonwealth or in
- 16 any territory or area under the jurisdiction of the United
- 17 States; or service as an administrator, teacher, or
- instructor in the field of education for any agency or 18

- department of the government of the United States, whether or
- 2 not such area was under the jurisdiction of the United
- 3 States, the total of such service not exceeding the lesser of
- 4 ten years or the number of years of active membership in the
- 5 system, as an officer or employee of the Department of
- 6 Education or as an administrator, teacher, or instructor
- 7 employed in any State-owned educational institution or The
- 8 Pennsylvania State University; [or]
- 9 (4) previous service with a governmental agency other
- 10 than the Commonwealth which employment with said agency was
- 11 terminated because of the transfer by statute of the
- administration of such service or of the entire agency to the
- Commonwealth[.]; or
- 14 (5) previous service with a redevelopment authority
- established pursuant to the act of May 24, 1945 (P.L.991, No.
- 16 <u>385), known as the Urban Redevelopment Law, not exceeding the</u>
- 17 lesser of ten years or the number of years service with an

- 20 Section 2. Section 5505 of Title 71 is amended by adding a
- 21 subsection to read:
- 22 § 5505. Contributions for the purchase of credit for creditable
- 23 nonstate service.

- 25 (f) Purchase of authority service. -- The amount due for the
- 26 purchase of credit for service with an authority shall be
- 27 determined by applying the member's basic contribution rate, the
- 28 <u>additional contribution rate plus the Commonwealth's normal</u>
- 29 contribution rate for active members at the time of entry,
- 30 subsequent to such service with an authority, of the member into

- 1 State service to his average annual rate of compensation over
- 2 the first three years of such subsequent State service and
- 3 <u>multiplying the result by the number of years and fractional</u>
- 4 part of a year of creditable service with an authority being
- 5 purchased together with statutory interest during all periods of
- 6 <u>subsequent State service to date of purchase. Upon application</u>
- 7 for credit for such service, payment shall be made in a lump sum
- 8 within 30 days or in the case of an active member it may be
- 9 <u>amortized with statutory interest through salary deductions in</u>
- 10 <u>amounts agreed upon by the member and the board. Application may</u>
- 11 be filed for all such credit for service with an authority upon
- 12 <u>completion of three years of subsequent State service and shall</u>
- 13 be credited as Class A service.
- 14 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
