## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, providing for replacement of deteriorated
- 3 registration plates.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 1333.1. Replacement of deteriorated registration plates.
- 9 The department shall replace, free of charge, a registration
- 10 plate that has deteriorated due to time, weather or other causes
- 11 upon the request of the registrant of a vehicle. Upon receipt of
- 12 the replacement plate, it shall be the duty of the registrant to
- 13 return the deteriorated plate to the department.
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
