AN ACT

Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for a right of 2 action to recover additional costs incurred for certain civil 4 actions. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: § 8503. Commonwealth right to recover additional costs. 10 (a) Commonwealth projects. -- In a civil action against the Commonwealth regarding a project, the Commonwealth may recover 11 from the plaintiff the additional costs caused by the delay to 12 13 the scheduled completion of the project, provided that: 14 (1) The court determines that the additional costs were 15 directly caused by the commencement of the action or any dilatory, obdurate or vexatious conduct of the plaintiff 16 during the pendency of the action. 17

(2) The action is dismissed against the plaintiff,

- 1 discontinued or decided in favor of the Commonwealth on the
- 2 merits or otherwise.
- 3 (b) Constitutional or statutory challenges.--In any civil
- 4 <u>action against the Commonwealth where the plaintiff challenges</u>
- 5 the constitutionality of a statute and seeks to prevent the
- 6 <u>implementation of the statute</u>, or where the plaintiff challenges
- 7 the lawfulness of an agency's implementation of a statute, the
- 8 Commonwealth may recover from the plaintiff the additional costs
- 9 incurred by any delay to the implementation of the statute,
- 10 provided that:
- 11 (1) The court determines that the additional costs were
- 12 <u>directly caused by the commencement of the action or any</u>
- dilatory, obdurate or vexatious conduct of the plaintiff
- during the pendency of the action.
- 15 (2) The court determines that the statute in question is
- 16 <u>constitutional or the agency's implementation of the statute</u>
- was lawful.
- 18 (c) Claim for additional costs.--The Commonwealth may
- 19 request recovery of the additional costs in the same civil
- 20 action at any time, provided that prior to submitting the
- 21 request, the Commonwealth:
- 22 (1) Estimates the additional costs to the project, or to
- 23 the implementation of the statute, if the litigation causes
- or is expected to cause delay.
- 25 (2) Provides the plaintiff with the estimate of the
- 26 <u>additional costs and notifies the plaintiff that the</u>
- 27 Commonwealth intends to seek recovery of the additional costs
- 28 <u>under this section.</u>
- 29 <u>(d) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following</u>
- 30 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this

- 1 <u>subsection:</u>
- "Agency." Any executive agency or independent agency of this 2
- 3 <u>Commonwealth</u>.
- 4 "Plaintiff." The party that commences the civil action,
- 5 <u>including an individual, corporation, business entity, interest</u>
- 6 group or political subdivision.
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
