AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 21, 1939 (P.L.626, No.294), entitled "An act providing for and regulating the assessment and 3 valuation of all subjects of taxation in counties of the second class; creating and prescribing the powers and duties of a Board of Property Assessment, Appeals and Review; imposing duties on certain county and city officers; abolishing the board for the assessment and revision of taxes in such counties; and prescribing penalties, " providing for 8 access to data and cards relating to taxable property. 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 11 hereby enacts as follows: 12 Section 1. Section 18, act of June 21, 1939 (P.L.626, 13 No. 294), referred to as the Second Class County Assessment Law, 14 is amended to read:
- 15 Section 18. Any taxpayer [may] shall, at any time during
- 16 office hours, have access to [the records of] data, cards and
- 17 records relating to taxable property and shall be permitted to
- 18 copy therefrom [a list of taxable property].
- 19 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
