## AN ACT

Amending the act of May 31, 1945 (P.L.1198, No.418), entitled, 2 as amended, "An act providing for the conservation and improvement of land affected in connection with surface 3 mining; regulating such mining; providing for the 5 establishment of an Emergency Bond Fund for anthracite deep 6 mine operators; and providing penalties, "restricting the 7 granting of permits for surface mining in the vicinity of 8 dwellings not having a public water supply. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 hereby enacts as follows: 11 Section 1. Section 4.2(c) of the act of May 31, 1945 (P.L.1198, No.418), known as the Surface Mining Conservation and 12 13 Reclamation Act, amended October 10, 1980 (P.L.835, No.155), is 14 amended to read: Section 4.2. General Rule Making; Health and Safety .-- \* \* \* 15 16 (c) From the effective date of this act, as amended hereby, 17 no operator shall conduct surface mining operations (other than 18 borrow pits for highway construction purposes) within one hundred feet of the outside line of the right-of-way of any 19 public highway or within three hundred feet of any occupied 20

- 1 dwelling, unless released by the owner thereof, nor within three
- 2 hundred feet of any public building, public park, school,
- 3 church, community or institutional building or within one
- 4 hundred feet of any cemetery. The secretary may grant operators
- 5 variances to the distance requirements herein established where
- 6 he is satisfied that special circumstances warrant such
- 7 exceptions and that the interest of the public and landowners
- 8 affected thereby will be adequately protected. Prior to granting
- 9 any such variances, the operator shall be required to give
- 10 public notice of his application therefor in two newspapers of
- 11 general circulation in the area once a week for two successive
- 12 weeks. Should any person file an exception to the proposed
- 13 variance within twenty days of the last publication thereof, the
- 14 department shall conduct a public hearing with respect thereto.
- 15 Notwithstanding any other provisions of this act, the department
- 16 <u>shall not grant a permit for a surface mining operation for any</u>
- 17 <u>area the outside boundary of which is within two thousand six</u>
- 18 <u>hundred forty linear feet (one-half mile) of any occupied</u>
- 19 dwelling that is not served by a public water supply, unless the
- 20 <u>owner of the dwelling has executed a release.</u>

- 22 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
