A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 2 3	Providing for the appointment of a nonpartisan commission to investigate all aspects of the fiscal structure and operations of the City of Philadelphia.
4	WHEREAS, The City of Philadelphia is facing a very real
5	financial crisis; and
6	WHEREAS, Mayor Goode, in a televised speech on August 20,
7	1990, said that Philadelphia faces a possible fiscal
8	"catastrophe"; and
9	WHEREAS, During the speech, the Mayor said that his
10	administration was considering selling or leasing some city-
11	owned properties and raised the possibility of layoffs of
12	municipal employees; and
13	WHEREAS, The Mayor said that the city "will run low on
14	readily available cash next spring"; and
15	WHEREAS, The City of Philadelphia clearly needs assistance to
16	resolve the massive fiscal problems it faces; therefore be it
17	RESOLVED (the House of Representatives concurring), That the
18	President pro tempore of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of

Representatives, the minority leader of the Senate and the
minority leader of the House of Representatives appoint a
nonpartisan commission to investigate and examine all aspects of
Philadelphia's fiscal structure and operations; and be it
further

6 RESOLVED, That the commission shall consist of such members 7 as the legislative leaders determine to be appropriate but shall 8 include officials of the City of Philadelphia from both 9 political parties and persons who possess established expertise

10 in municipal finance; and be it further

11 RESOLVED, That appointments to the commission shall be made 12 as expeditiously as possible and the commission shall meet and 13 organize with dispatch; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the commission hold hearings, take testimony and make its investigation and examination in such manner and at such places as it deems necessary; and be it further

17 RESOLVED, That the commission issue a preliminary report of 18 its findings, together with its recommendations, 60 days after 19 the date of adoption of this concurrent resolution; and be it 20 further

21 RESOLVED, That the commission issue a final report six months 22 after the date of adoption of this concurrent resolution.
