- 10 popularity over the years, and it is now a recognized

- 12 WHEREAS, "National Physical Therapy Month" provides an
- 13 opportunity for physical therapists and physical therapist
- 14 assistants nationwide to educate their communities about who
- 15 physical therapists are and what they can do; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Physical therapists are experts in restoring and
- improving the motion that is so crucial to a patient's well-17

- 3 (1) improve mobility and quality of life, in many cases
- 4 without surgery or prescription drugs;
- 5 (2) apply their intensive education and clinical

- 7 (3) teach patients how to prevent or manage their health
- 8 condition so that they will achieve an improved quality of
