A RESOLUTION

1 2	Designating January 1 through 8, 2016, as "First Responder Appreciation Week" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, Thousands of Pennsylvanians have benefited from the
4	brave and courageous service of first responders across this
5	Commonwealth; and
6	WHEREAS, The police, fire, emergency medical service and
7	public health personnel who are commonly known as first
8	responders work tirelessly and selflessly for the residents of
9	this Commonwealth, regardless of any personal peril and hazard;
10	and
11	WHEREAS, The men and women who bravely serve as first
12	responders find themselves on the front lines of homeland
13	defense in the war against terrorism; and
14	WHEREAS, First responders are called upon to serve the
15	residents of this Commonwealth in the event of natural
16	disasters; and

1 WHEREAS, First responders across this Commonwealth risk their 2 lives every day to make our communities safe, including 55,000 3 registered emergency medical service workers, 75,000 4 firefighters and over 45,000 police officers; and

5 WHEREAS, Emergency medical service workers respond to and 6 treat many life-threatening emergencies, from traumatic injuries 7 and strokes to cardiac arrest; and

8 WHEREAS, Both volunteer and career firefighters provide 9 critical fire prevention safety and education, fire suppression, 10 automobile accident response, search and rescue and hazardous 11 material response, and often provide emergency medical services 12 when needed at the scene; and

13 WHEREAS, Police officers protect our lives and properties,14 prevent and detect crimes and ensure justice; and

WHEREAS, First responders make personal sacrifices in order to keep this Commonwealth safe and sometimes make the ultimate sacrifice in the line of duty to ensure the well-being of the residents of this Commonwealth; and

19 WHEREAS, These men and women should be honored the first week 20 of the year to show our renewed respect, appreciation and 21 gratitude for those who carry out the critical role of 22 protecting and ensuring public safety for all of us; therefore 23 be it

RESOLVED, That the Senate designate January 1 through 8,
2016, as "First Responder Appreciation Week" in Pennsylvania.
