6	WHEREAS, Annual "National Thrift Week" observances from 1916
7	through 1966 highlighted the value of hard work and fiscal
8	discipline and the cultivation of thrift as an American ideal;

10	WHEREAS, Communities nationwide first celebrated "National
11	Thrift Week" in 1916 with the opening of school savings accounts
12	for children and workplace savings programs; and
13	WHEREAS, The 1916 observance was launched on January 17, the
14	birthday anniversary of early American inventor, author,
15	printer, scientist, philanthropist, statesman and diplomat
16	Benjamin Franklin, who was recognized as the "American apostle
17	of thrift"; and
18	WHEREAS, "National Thrift Week" is no longer celebrated or
19	fully recognized; and

1 WHEREAS, The nation and many individuals and families are 2 facing difficult financial conditions today; and 3 WHEREAS, Recession, unemployment and widespread pay cuts have 4 spurred individuals and governments to reassess financial 5 practices; and

6 WHEREAS, Restoring and instilling thrift and fiscal responsibility as guiding principles for individuals and 7 8 governments can aid our return to an era of sound financial management and economic prosperity; therefore be it 9 10 RESOLVED, That the Senate observe the month of January 2014 as "Pennsylvania Thrift Month," observe the week of January 17 11 through 23, 2014, as "National Thrift Week" and call on 12 13 individuals, families and government at all levels to exercise 14 thrift and fiscal responsibility.
