AN ACT

- Amending Title 58 (Oil and Gas) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for lease extended by production.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Title 58 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 6 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 7 § 3213.1. Lease extended by production.
- 8 (a) Prohibition. -- Any portion of land subject to a lease,
- 9 which is combined with other lands or leases to form a unit,
- 10 shall be subject to operations and production on and in the
- 11 unit. The operations and production shall continue a lease in
- 12 <u>force and effect during or after the primary term according to</u>
- 13 the lease provisions only as to that portion of the leased land
- 14 which is included in the unit. Any land covered by a lease and
- 15 not included in the unit shall not be subject to operations or
- 16 production on or in the unit. The lease may be kept in force in
- 17 any manner provided in the lease agreement for leased land not
- 18 included in an agreement.

- 1 (b) Applicability.--
- 2 (1) Subsection (a) shall apply to any unit formed after
- 3 the effective date of this section.
- 4 (2) This section shall only apply to lease interests in
- 5 <u>an unconventional reservoir.</u>
- 6 (c) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
- 7 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 8 <u>subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 9 <u>"Unconventional reservoir." A formation below the base of</u>
- 10 the Elk Sandstone or its geologic equivalent stratigraphic
- 11 <u>interval that contains or produces oil or gas that generally</u>
- 12 cannot be economically produced at flow rates or in volumes
- 13 except by hydraulic fracturing, horizontal or multilateral well
- 14 bores or other techniques to expose the reservoir to the well
- 15 bore.
- 16 "Unit." A consolidation of interests of persons actively
- 17 engaged in the business of extracting oil or gas from land owned
- 18 or leased by the persons within a defined geographic area to
- 19 <u>facilitate the drilling of wells from one or more unconventional</u>
- 20 <u>reservoirs.</u>
- 21 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
