- 2 drivers and urging observance of October 2, 2008, as "DUI
- 3 Victims' Memorial Day."
- 4 WHEREAS, More than 500 people are killed every year in this
- 5 Commonwealth because of intoxicated drivers; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania DUI Association has been battling
- 7 drunk driving for the past 29 years and has helped the DUI death
- 8 rate drop from over 700 people in 1988 to just over 500 people
- 9 in 2007; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania DUI Association honors victims of
- 11 intoxicated drivers by maintaining the DUI Victims' Memorial
- 12 Garden at 2413 North Front Street in Harrisburg; therefore be it
- 13 RESOLVED, That the Senate observe October 2, 2008, as "DUI
- 14 Victims' Memorial Day" and commemorate the lives of those
- 15 persons killed by intoxicated drivers.
