A RESOLUTION

1 Designating October 24, 2014, as "Acupuncture and Oriental
2 Medicine Day" in Pennsylvania to honor the more than 700
3 licensed acupuncturists in this Commonwealth.

11 education, credentialing and personal commitment; and

13 acupuncturists and oriental medicine practitioners each year;

16 medical services understand the full realm of available options
17 for competent, professional, integrated health care; therefore
