## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for
- disposition of delinquent children.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 6352(a)(5) of Title 42 of the
- 7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 6352. Disposition of delinquent child.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- If the child is found to be a delinquent
- 10 child the court may make any of the following orders of
- 11 disposition best suited to his treatment, supervision,
- 12 rehabilitation, and welfare:
- 13 \* \* \*
- (5) Ordering payment by the child of reasonable amounts
- of money as fines, costs or restitution as deemed appropriate
- as part of the plan of rehabilitation considering the nature
- of the acts committed and the earning capacity of the child.
- 18 If an order is made under this paragraph, the court shall

- 1 retain jurisdiction until there has been full compliance with
- 2 <u>the order. The fact that the individual subject to the order</u>
- 3 <u>attains the age of 18 before full compliance has no effect on</u>
- 4 jurisdiction. Additional costs incurred by the county as a
- 5 result of retaining jurisdiction shall be sustained by the
- 6 <u>delinquent child.</u>
- 7 \* \* \*
- 8 Section 2. This act shall apply to all orders issued under
- 9 42 Pa.C.S. § 6352(a)(5) regardless of the date the order was
- 10 issued.
- 11 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
