- 9 SECTION 1. SECTION 201, INSOFAR AS IT RELATES TO THE
- 10 GOVERNOR AND THE DEPARTMENTS OF EDUCATION AND HEALTH, ACT OF
- 11 JULY 1, 1981 (P.L.628, NO.5A), KNOWN AS THE "GENERAL
- 12 APPROPRIATION ACT OF 1981," IS AMENDED TO READ:
- 13 SECTION 201. THE FOLLOWING SUMS, OR AS MUCH THEREOF AS MAY
- 14 BE NECESSARY, ARE HEREBY SPECIFICALLY APPROPRIATED FROM THE
- 15 GENERAL FUND TO THE SEVERAL HEREINAFTER NAMED AGENCIES OF THE
- 16 EXECUTIVE, LEGISLATIVE AND JUDICIAL DEPARTMENTS OF THE
- 17 COMMONWEALTH FOR THE PAYMENT OF SALARIES, WAGES OR OTHER
- 18 COMPENSATION AND TRAVEL EXPENSE OF THE DULY ELECTED OR APPOINTED
- 19 OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMONWEALTH, FOR PAYMENT OF FEES
- 20 OF CONTRACTUAL SERVICES RENDERED, FOR THE PURCHASE OR RENTAL OF
- 21 GOODS, SERVICES, PRINTING, EQUIPMENT, LAND AND BUILDINGS AND FOR
- 22 PAYMENT OF ANY OTHER EXPENSES, AS PROVIDED BY LAW OR BY THIS
- 23 ACT, NECESSARY FOR THE PROPER CONDUCT OF THE DUTIES, FUNCTIONS
- 24 AND ACTIVITIES AND FOR THE PURPOSES HEREINAFTER SET FORTH FOR
- 25 THE FISCAL PERIOD BEGINNING JULY 1, 1981 AND FOR THE PAYMENT OF
- 26 BILLS INCURRED AND REMAINING UNPAID AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL
- 27 PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1981.
