Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for aggravated 3 assault. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 2702(c) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: § 2702. Aggravated assault. 9 \* \* \* 10 (c) Officers, employees, etc., enumerated.--The officers, agents, employees and other persons referred to in subsection 11 12 (a) shall be as follows: 13 (1) Police officer. 14 (2) Firefighter. 15 County adult probation or parole officer. (3) 16 (4)County juvenile probation or parole officer.
