Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, further providing for maximum axle weight of 3 vehicles. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 4943(b)(3), (4) and (6) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 7 8 § 4943. Maximum axle weight of vehicles. 9 * * * 10 (b) Exceptions and special applications. --11 (3) No trucks registered in Classes 17 and 20 shall have 12 13 an overall gross weight in excess of 21,400 pounds on any tandem axle. In addition, a group of three tandem axles shall 14 15 not have an overall gross weight in excess of 60,000 pounds. 16 This paragraph shall not be applicable to interstate 17 highways[.] except for a highway added to the interstate system under the National Highway System Designation Act of 18
