AN ACT

Abolishing the office of constable in the City of Philadelphia and providing for the performance of duties under The Landlord and Tenant Act of 1951.

- 1 THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA HEREBY
- 2 ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:
- 3 Section 1. The office of constable in the City of Philadelphia is hereby abolished
- 4 and the terms of office of all incumbents are hereby terminated.
- 5 Section 2. The duties heretofore performed by constables under the act of
- 6 April 6, 1951 (P. L. 69), known as "The Landlord and Tenant Act of 1951," shall be
- 7 performed by the landlord and tenant officers of the Municipal Court of Philadelphia.
- 8 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
