The State Department of Health hereafter referred to as the department, shall establish a program for the care and 10 treatment of persons suffering from chronic renal diseases. Funds may be provided for <-developing home dialysis treatment services and the necessary 7 <-specialized personnel and equipment. Funds-for-construction-of the-centers-may-also-be-provided. The-centers THE DEPARTMENT <-shall develop and utilize newer methods of dialysis designed to 10 make the process more efficient and economical and shall take 11 into account other applications of the procedure such as home 12 dialysis. Genters THE DEPARTMENT may seek the active 13 <--14 participation and consultation from industry in order to streamline equipment and procedures for greater efficiency. THE 15 <--DEPARTMENT, WITH THE ADVICE OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE, SHALL 16 17 DEVELOP STANDARDS FOR DETERMINING ELIGIBILITY FOR CARE AND TREATMENT UNDER THIS PROGRAM. 18 19 The dialysis-centers DEPARTMENT shall also serve Section 3. <--20 to provide training for medical and nursing personnel who will 21 carry out dialysis services in other communities in the State. 22 The dialysis-centers DEPARTMENT may also work in close <--23 cooperation with other medical specialists who are seeking ways 24 to develop successful means of kidney transplantation. Dialysis 25 services are necessary as an adjunct to this type of medical 26 investigation. 27 Section 4. The Secretary of Health hereafter referred to as 28 the secretary, shall appoint a Renal Disease Advisory Committee, 29 hereafter referred to as the committee, to consult with the
