## AN ACT

- Amending the act of October 27, 1955 (P.L.744), entitled, as 2 amended, "An act prohibiting certain practices of 3 discrimination because of race, color, religious creed, 4 ancestry, age or national origin by employers, employment 5 agencies, labor organizations and others as herein defined; 6 creating the Pennsylvania Human Relations Commission in the 7 Department of Labor and Industry; defining its functions, powers and duties; providing for procedure and enforcement; 8 providing for formulation of an educational program to 9 10 prevent prejudice; providing for judicial review and 11 enforcement and imposing penalties, "eliminating provisions relating to the educational program and further defining 12 13 "place of public accommodation." 14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 15 hereby enacts as follows: 16 Section 1. Clause (1) of section 4, act of October 27, 1955 17 (P.L.744), known as the "Pennsylvania Human Relations Act," amended December 10, 1970 (P.L.882), is amended to read: 18 19 Section 4. Definitions. -- As used in this act unless a 20 different meaning clearly appears from the context: 21
- 22 (1) The term "place of public accommodation, resort or

- 1 amusement" means any place which is open to, accepts or solicits
- 2 the patronage of the general public, including but not limited
- 3 to inns, taverns, roadhouses, hotels, motels, whether conducted
- 4 for the entertainment of transient guests or for the
- 5 accommodation of those seeking health, recreation or rest, or
- 6 restaurants or eating houses, or any place where food is sold
- 7 for consumption on the premises, buffets, saloons, barrooms or
- 8 any store, park or enclosure where spirituous or malt liquors
- 9 are sold, ice cream parlors, confectioneries, soda fountains and
- 10 all stores where ice cream, ice and fruit preparations or their
- 11 derivatives, or where beverages of any kind are retailed for
- 12 consumption on the premises, drug stores, dispensaries, clinics,
- 13 hospitals, bathhouses, swimming pools, barber shops, beauty
- 14 parlors, retail stores and establishments, theatres, motion
- 15 picture houses, airdromes, roof gardens, music halls, race
- 16 courses, skating rinks, amusement and recreation parks, fairs,
- 17 bowling alleys, gymnasiums, shooting galleries, billiard and
- 18 pool parlors, public libraries, [kindergartens, primary and
- 19 secondary schools, high schools, academies, colleges and
- 20 universities, extension courses and all educational institutions
- 21 under the supervision of this Commonwealth,] nonsectarian
- 22 cemeteries, garages and all public conveyances operated on land
- 23 or water or in the air as well as the stations, terminals and
- 24 airports thereof, but shall not include any accommodations which
- 25 are in their nature distinctly private.

- 27 Section 2. Section 8 of the act is repealed.
