AN ACT

- 1 Making an appropriation to the Carnegie Museum at Pittsburgh,
- 2 Pennsylvania to meet the museum deficit for the 1970-71
- 3 fiscal year.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The sum of twenty-four thousand dollars
- 7 (\$24,000), or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby
- 8 specifically appropriated to the Carnegie Museum at Pittsburgh,
- 9 Pennsylvania to meet the museum deficit caused by the failure to
- 10 make the full appropriation in the fiscal year 1970-71 because
- 11 of insufficient revenues, for maintenance and the purchase of
- 12 apparatus, supplies and equipment.
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1971.
