AN ACT

1 Making an appropriation to the Carnegie Museum at Pittsburgh,  
2 Pennsylvania to meet the museum deficit for the 1970-71  
3 fiscal year.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. The sum of twenty-four thousand dollars  
7 (\$24,000), or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby  
8 specifically appropriated to the Carnegie Museum at Pittsburgh,  
9 Pennsylvania to meet the museum deficit caused by the failure to  
10 make the full appropriation in the fiscal year 1970-71 because  
11 of insufficient revenues, for maintenance and the purchase of  
12 apparatus, supplies and equipment.

13 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1971.
