AN ACT

Making an appropriation to the Trustees of the University of 1 2 Pittsburgh to meet an institute and clinic deficit for the 3 1970-71 fiscal year incurred for the general maintenance and operation of the Western Psychiatric Institute and Clinic. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. The sum of one million one hundred twenty-five 8 thousand dollars (\$1,125,000), or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby specifically appropriated to the Trustees 9 10 of the University of Pittsburgh to meet an institute and clinic 11 deficit caused by the failure to make the full appropriation in the fiscal year 1970-71 because of insufficient revenues, for 12 13 the general maintenance and operation of the Western Psychiatric Institute and Clinic by the University of Pittsburgh and the 14 15 purchase of such apparatus and equipment as the trustees may 16 deem necessary for the best interest of the purposes of the 17 institute and clinic, which purposes shall include the teaching of personnel for the staffs of the various mental institutions 18

of the Commonwealth and the conduct of research in the

- 1 treatment, prevention and cause of the various types of nervous
- 2 disorders and mental diseases in compliance with the laws,
- 3 providing for the lease of the Western Psychiatric Institute and
- 4 Clinic to the University of Pittsburgh. In addition to the above
- 5 amount all income and all moneys collected at the institute and
- 6 paid into the General Fund of the State Treasury under existing
- 7 laws are hereby appropriated out of the General Fund to the
- 8 institute for the same purposes, the institute to receive from
- 9 such appropriation the exact amount which was collected at said
- 10 institute during the said fiscal period.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1971.
