29	Section 11. Where any of the officers herein mentioned hold						
30	30 two or more of the offices for which a salary is herein fixed,

- 3 one thousand dollars (\$1,000) per annum.
- 4 Section 12. (a) The county officers shall be paid only the
- 5 salary provided herein for services performed for the county or
- 6 any other governmental unit.
- 7 (b) All fees and commissions received in the conduct of any
- 8 county office shall be paid directly to the county. Fees shall
- 9 not be deemed to include reimbursement for mileage.
- 10 Section 13. This act shall take effect immediately and shall
- 11 apply to all county officers elected or appointed on or after
- 12 the Tuesday next following the first Monday of November, 1971.
