INTRODUCED BY AMMERMAN AND MELLOW, OCTOBER 12, 1971

REFERRED TO HIGHWAYS, OCTOBER 12, 1971

AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 22, 1931 (P.L.594), entitled "An act
2 establishing certain township roads as State highways;
3 authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement
4 under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the
5 obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain
6 structures located on such highways; conferring certain
7 powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities,
8 persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost
9 of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and
10 making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said
11 act," deleting a route in Haines Township, Centre County.

12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
13 hereby enacts as follows:

14 Section 1. Route 14046, act of June 22, 1931 (P.L.594),
15 entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State
16 highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance and
17 improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting
18 the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of
19 certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain
20 powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities,
21 persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of
22 the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an
23 appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," added

1 July 12, 1935 (P.L.806), is deleted to read:

2 CENTRE COUNTY

3 * * *

4 [Route 14046. Beginning at a point on Route 27 about 0.5 of
5 a mile west of Fiedler; thence in a northerly, easterly, and
6 southerly direction, through Haines Township to a point on Route
7 27, about 0.1 of a mile west of Woodward, in Centre County, a
8 distance of about 4.6 miles.]

9 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
