AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of July 7, 1972 (No.17-A), entitled "An act to
- 2 provide for the expenses of the Executive, Legislative and
- Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and
- for the public schools for the fiscal year July 1, 1972 to
- 5 June 30, 1973, and for the payment of bills incurred and
- 6 remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending
- June 30, 1972, changing, adding and deleting certain
- 8 appropriations to the Executive and Legislative Departments.
- 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 10 hereby enacts as follows:
- 11 Section 1. As much as relates to certain appropriations to
- 12 the Departments of Community Affairs, Education, Health,
- 13 Justice, Property and Supplies, Public Welfare and State and to
- 14 the Senate, House of Representatives and the Legislative
- 15 Reference Bureau in section 2, act of July 7, 1972 (No.17-A),
- 16 known as "The General Appropriation Act of 1972," is amended and
- 17 an appropriation to the Department of Education is added after
- 18 the appropriation to public libraries to read:
- 19 Section 2. The following sums, or as much thereof as may be
- 20 necessary, are hereby specifically appropriated from the General
- 21 Fund to the several hereinafter named agencies of the Executive,
- 22 Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth for the
- 23 payment of the salaries, wages or other compensation and travel
- 24 expense of the duly elected or appointed officers and employes
- 25 of the Commonwealth, for payment of fees of contractual services
- 26 rendered, for the purchase or rental of goods, services,
- 27 printing, equipment, land and buildings and for payment of any
- 28 other expenses, as provided by law or by this act, necessary for
- 29 the proper conduct of the duties, functions and activities and
- 30 for the purposes hereinafter set forth for the fiscal year
- 31 beginning July 1, 1972, and for the payment of bills incurred
