INTRODUCED BY SALVATORE, HAMILTON, KATZ, PERRI AND CHECCHIO, FEBRUARY 26, 1973

REFERRED TO COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION, FEBRUARY 26, 1973

AN ACT

Amending the act of April 29, 1959 (P.L.58, No.32), entitled "An act consolidating and revising the Vehicle Code, the Tractor Code, the Motor Vehicle Financial Responsibility Act and other acts relating to the ownership, possession and use of vehicles and tractors," requiring operators' license cards to bear a photograph of the licensee and to be laminated.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Section 611, act of April 29, 1959 (P.L.58, No.32), known as "The Vehicle Code," amended July 25, 1963 (P.L.312, No.166), is amended to read:

Section 611. Licenses Issued to Operators.--
(a) The department shall issue to every person licensed as an operator an operator's license card.
(b) Every such card shall bear thereon the operator's license number, the name, address, and such other information as may be required, a black and white photograph of the licensee to be furnished by the licensee with his application and, to be replaced every five (5) years unless sooner required because of deterioration or other necessary cause and also a space for the
signature of the licensee.
(c) No signature or facsimile signature of the secretary shall be contained on any such card or duplicate thereof issued for the license period beginning February 1, 1965, nor for any subsequent license period, but each such card or duplicate thereof shall be sealed with the facsimile seal of the department.
(d) Such license card or duplicate thereof shall be laminated.

Section 2. This act shall take effect with respect to all operator licenses issued on and after January 1, 1974.
