AN ACT

Amending the act of August 23, 1967 (P.L.251, No.102), entitled, as amended, "An act providing for the incorporation as public 2 3 instrumentalities of the Commonwealth and as bodies corporate 4 and politic of industrial and commercial development authorities for municipalities, counties and townships; 6 prescribing the rights, powers and duties of such authorities 7 hereafter incorporated; authorizing such authorities to 8 acquire, by gift or purchase, to construct, improve and 9 maintain industrial or commercial development projects including projects for the elimination or prevention of blight and the control of air and water pollution, and to 10 11 12 borrow money and issue bonds therefor; providing for the 13 payment of such bonds and giving security therefor, and 14 prescribing the rights of the holders of such bonds; 15 authorizing the lease or sale of industrial or commercial 16 development projects to industrial, commercial, manufacturing 17 or research and development enterprises; authorizing any 18 county, municipality or township to transfer or convey to 19 such authorities, any facilities or property available for 20 industrial or commercial development projects; exempting the 21 property and securities of such authorities from taxation; 22 authorizing such authorities to enter into contracts with and 23 to accept grants from the Federal Government or any agency 24 thereof; and providing for approval by the Secretary of 25 Commerce of the proceedings relating to industrial or 26 commercial development projects of such authorities," 27 defining "energy conservation," "product line conversion," 28 and "energy production" projects and providing for sponsoring 29 and acceptance thereof.

- The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 31 hereby enacts as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 3, act of August 23, 1967 (P.L.251,
- 2 No.102), known as the "Industrial and Commercial Development
- 3 Authority Law, " is amended by adding clauses to read:
- 4 Section 3. Definitions.--As used in this act:
- 5 * * *
- 6 (22) "Energy conservation projects" means any undertaking to
- 7 <u>substantially reduce the amount of energy consumed in the</u>
- 8 operation of an industrial or commercial enterprise, including
- 9 but not limited to the installation of insulation,
- 10 weatherproofing, energy saving or recycling equipment and
- 11 devices, and any energy source conversion project, such as from
- 12 <u>oil to coal, which are necessitated by a lack of availability of</u>
- 13 an energy-producing resource, when such a lack of availability
- 14 is declared to exist by the Governor of the Commonwealth. A
- 15 <u>"substantial" reduction in the amount of energy consumed shall</u>
- 16 <u>be fifteen percent or more.</u>
- 17 (23) "Product line conversion projects" means any
- 18 <u>undertaking to alter or replace equipment or buildings in order</u>
- 19 to continue the operations of an industrial enterprise when such
- 20 <u>conversion is necessitated by a lack of availability of a raw</u>
- 21 <u>materials component of the existing product line: Provided, That</u>
- 22 the lack of availability of the raw material must first be
- 23 <u>declared to exist by the Governor of the Commonwealth.</u>
- 24 (24) "Energy production projects" means any undertaking to
- 25 <u>create</u>, <u>extract</u>, <u>transmit</u>, <u>or store energy or energy producing</u>
- 26 <u>substances</u>, including, but not limited to coal mine operations,
- 27 oil and gas operations, solar, nuclear, or geothermal energy
- 28 operations.
- 29 Section 2. Subsection (b) of section 6 of the act is amended
- 30 by adding a clause to read:

- 2 (b) Every authority is hereby granted, and shall have and
- 3 may exercise all powers necessary or convenient for the carrying
- 4 out of the aforesaid purposes, including but without limiting
- 5 the generality of the foregoing, the following rights and
- 6 powers:

- 8 (17) An authority created hereunder may sponsor energy
- 9 conservation projects, product line conversion projects, and
- 10 <u>energy production projects.</u>

- 12 Section 3. Clause (4) of subsection (d) of section 6 of the
- 13 act, amended December 29, 1971 (P.L.647, No.171), is amended to
- 14 read:

- 16 (d) An authority created hereunder shall have no power to:
- 17 * * *
- 18 (4) Finance machinery or equipment except in conjunction
- 19 with the construction of a new, or the improvement of an
- 20 existing industrial or commercial development project, but such
- 21 prohibition shall not relate to the financing of pollution
- 22 control facilities, energy conservation projects, product line
- 23 <u>conversion projects</u>, or <u>energy production projects</u>; or
