AN ACT

1 Amending the act of April 29, 1959 (P.L.58, No.32), entitled "An
2 act consolidating and revising the Vehicle Code, the Tractor
3 Code, the Motor Vehicle Financial Responsibility Act and
4 other acts relating to the ownership, possession and use of
5 vehicles and tractors," providing for additional lamps on
6 certain emergency vehicles.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. Subsection (d) of section 802, act of April 29,
10 1959 (P.L.58, No.32), known as "The Vehicle Code," is amended to
11 read:

12 Section 802. Additional Lights and Devices.--

13 * * *

14 (d) Warning Devices.--Any vehicle, used exclusively for
15 repair or emergency purposes, may be equipped with, not to
16 exceed, [one (1)] five (5) warning [lamp] lamps of a type
17 approved by the secretary, to be used only in connection with
18 repair or emergency work while the vehicle is stationary. The
19 five (5) lamps shall be affixed to the vehicle in the following
20 manner:

- 1 (1) Two (2) lamps on the front;
- 2 (2) Two (2) lamps on the rear; and
- 3 (3) One (1) lamp atop of the vehicle.
