б	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7	hereby enacts as follows:
8	Section 1. Section 701, act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1225,
9	No.316), known as "The Game Law," amended June 13, 1961
10	(P.L.296, No.175), is amended to read:
11	Section 701. Unlawful Taking, Killing, Possession, Etc., of
12	GameExcept as otherwise provided in this act, it is unlawful
13	for any person to take or kill or wound or attempt to take or
14	kill or wound, or assist in the taking, killing or wounding of
15	any game, except during the open season, or to have in
16	possession, either living or dead, any game, or any part
17	thereof, except game lawfully taken during the open season which
18	may be had in possession up to and including [July first] August
19	thirty-first OF THE year immediately following.

1 The burden of proof that game, or any part thereof, found in 2 possession of any person after the close of the open season was 3 lawfully taken shall be upon the person in whose possession such 4 game, or part thereof, is found.

5 This section does not prohibit the possession at any time of 6 game killed or taken outside of this Commonwealth, or the 7 possession of the tanned or cured skins, or any parts thereof, 8 of birds or animals now unlawfully killed, or the possession of 9 live raccoons when lawfully taken during the open season.

10 It is unlawful for any person to use any game that has been 11 unlawfully killed or taken, or to aid or assist in the taking, 12 possessing, concealment, or transportation of any game 13 unlawfully killed, or to have in possession for any purpose 14 whatsoever, or conceal the same, any game, or any part thereof, 15 that has been unlawfully killed or taken.
