AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 26, 1974 (No.21-A), entitled "An act to
2 provide for the expenses of the Executive, Legislative and
3 Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and
4 for the public schools for the fiscal year July 1, 1974 to
5 June 30, 1975, and for the payment of bills incurred and
6 remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending
7 June 30, 1974; and providing for subpoena powers for
8 legislative appropriation committees," PROVIDING FOR <—
9 INCREASES IN CERTAIN APPROPRIATIONS MADE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF
10 ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES, THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND THE
11 DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WELFARE, FOR AN APPROPRIATION TO THE
12 DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND INDUSTRY, ADDING AN APPROPRIATION FOR
13 EMPLOYEES OF THE CHIEF CLERK OF THE SENATE, making deficiency
14 appropriations for incidental expenses and Legislative
15 printing and expenses of the House of Representatives, for
16 the House Special Leadership Account (R), and for the House <—
17 Special Leadership Account (D), FOR THE LEGISLATIVE BUDGET <—
18 AND FINANCE COMMITTEE AND PROVIDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF
19 NATIONAL FLAGS.

20 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
21 hereby enacts as follows:

7 LEGISLATIVE PRINTING AND EXPENSES OF THE HOUSE OF
8 REPRESENTATIVES AND THE LEGISLATIVE BUDGET AND FINANCE
9 COMMITTEE, AND BY AMENDING THE PURCHASE OF FLAGS BY THE GENERAL
10 ASSEMBLY; THE APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WELFARE,
11 THE LEGISLATIVE BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE, AND THE
12 APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURCHASE OF FLAGS, AMENDED AND the House
13 Special Leadership Accounts added December 13, 1974 (No.75-A),
14 are amended to read:

15 Section 2. The following sums, or as much thereof as may be
16 necessary, are hereby specifically appropriated from the General
17 Fund to the several hereinafter named agencies of the Executive,
18 Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth for the
19 payment of the salaries, wages or other compensation and travel
20 expense of the duly elected or appointed officers and employees
21 of the Commonwealth, for payment of fees of contractual services
22 rendered, for the purchase or rental of goods, services,
23 printing, equipment, land and buildings and for payment of any
24 other expenses, as provided by law or by this act, necessary for
25 the proper conduct of the duties, functions and activities and
26 for the purposes hereinafter set forth for the fiscal year
27 beginning July 1, 1974 and for the payment of bills incurred and
28 remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June
29 30, 1974.
