## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), entitled,
- as amended, "An act relating to counties of the second class
- 3 and second class A; amending, revising, consolidating and
- 4 changing the laws relating thereto, discontinuing the
- 5 requirement that counties pay part of the cost of the food
- 6 stamp program.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 2198.1, act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723,
- 10 No.230), known as the "Second Class County Code," added December
- 11 1, 1965 (P.L.978, No.359), is amended to read:
- 12 Section 2198.1. Food Stamp Program. -- The board of
- 13 commissioners of any county of the second class may by
- 14 resolution adopt the food stamp program. Upon adoption of the
- 15 program the county shall appropriate money and shall pay,
- 16 quarterly from county funds, the amounts certified to the county
- 17 as being the obligations to the Department of Public Welfare for
- 18 thirty percent of the amount expended by the department for
- 19 administration of the food stamp program for the county during

- the fiscal year 1965-1966, for forty percent of the amount 1
- expended during the fiscal year 1966-1967 and for fifty percent 2
- 3 of the amount expended during the fiscal [year] years 1967-1968
- [and thereafter] through 1974-1975 and the six-month period 4
- ending December 31, 1975. 5
- Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 6
