AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1225, No.316), entitled
2 "An act concerning game and other wild birds and wild
3 animals; and amending, revising, consolidating, and changing
4 the law relating thereto," increasing the maximum purchase
5 price per acre the commission may pay for land.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. The first paragraph of section 903, act of June
9 3, 1937 (P.L.1225, No.316), known as "The Game Law," amended
10 October 26, 1972 (P.L.1019, No.248), is amended to read:

11 Section 903. Purchase Price.--For land to be used as State
12 Game Lands the commission may pay what it considers a fair and
13 reasonable price not exceeding [one hundred dollars] two hundred
14 dollars per acre exclusive of Federal and other cost-sharing
15 funds and consistent with the market value of land in the
16 locality in which any such land may be located.

18 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
