AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of July 19, 1974 (No.175), entitled "An act
- 2 requiring public agencies to hold certain meetings and
- 3 hearings open to the public and providing penalties,"
- 4 providing for certain executive sessions.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 3, act of July 19, 1974 (No.175),
- 8 entitled "An act requiring public agencies to hold certain
- 9 meetings and hearings open to the public and providing
- 10 penalties," is amended by adding a clause to read:
- 11 Section 3. No public meeting of any agency shall be
- 12 adjourned, begun, recessed or interrupted in any way for the
- 13 purpose of an executive session except as hereinafter provided.
- 14 An executive session may be held during the course of a properly
- 15 constituted public meeting upon notification to the public
- 16 present by the presiding officer that for a period not to exceed
- 17 thirty minutes the meeting will be in recess for the purpose of:
- 18 (1) Considering dismissal or disciplining of, or hearing
- 19 complaints or charges brought against a public elected officer,

- 1 employee, or other public agent unless such person requests a
- 2 public hearing.
- 3 (2) Considering actions of the deliberating body with
- 4 respect to labor negotiations.
- 5 (3) Receiving evidence or testimony at a meeting of any
- 6 committee of the General Assembly when such evidence or
- 7 testimony may tend to defame, degrade or incriminate any person.
- 8 No evidence or testimony taken in an executive session under
- 9 this clause may be released or used in public sessions without
- 10 the consent of the committee.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
